- 1. You apply for you stud prefix when you request your stud name.
- 2. Breed / Grade is the type of Boer Goat you are registering.
- 3. The year letter designates the year that the animal was born. Letters 'I' and 'O' are not used.
- 4. Number is the unique number you have designated for your animal. The standard is 4 digits so include '0' to fill the space ie 0001 for 1.

Breed Codes/Grade

- a. A Standard Fullblood Boer (F) is a fullblood boer with a white body and coloured head.
- b. A Red Boer (R) is a fullblood boer of solid colour.

Note - A Fullblood boer with **'Painted'** colour can be registered under the Standard (F) or Red (R) register depending on owner preference. This can be based on the animal's 'main colour' or the animals 'parentage'.

The "most relevant" colour option can be chosen under the Colour Drop Down Box on the registration request form.

Upgrade Registrations (Does Only)

Upgrade registration are be recorded as G1, G2, G3, G4, and GP (Graded Purebred).

G1 is progeny of a fullblood registered sire and foundation dam

G2 is progeny of a fullblood registered sire and G1 dam

G3 is progeny of a fullblood registered sire and G2 dam

G4 is progeny of a fullblood registered sire and G3 dam

GP is progeny of a fullblood registered sire and G4 dam
